

EVAC PER DIEM



EVAC Per Diem (DOS) applies when an employee is evacuated to Washington, D.C. or an authorized safehaven; it is not intended to fully reimburse, and normal family living expenses remain the employee's responsibility. Payable up to 180 days or until DOS ends it, the employee receives 100% of GSA locality per diem, or 150% when a "special family composition" applies (first evacuee plus specified non-spouse/non-partner family members); additional evacuees receive only a portion of M&IE. EVAC begins the day after arrival at the safehaven, and taxes are reimbursable.
